Sub: Testing of materials – in connection with construction of buildings etc.

Sir,

As you are aware that the process of modernization, upgradation and renovation of ESIC Buildings is in progress. It has been observed that the testing of materials being used in construction works (Construction/Repairs/Renovations/Face-lifting etc.) is not being done in the desired manner and as per the prescribed frequency. At many construction sites, the laboratory has not been set up.

In order to ensure the prescribed quality of the materials are used in the construction work, it has become essential to do the quality testing of materials being used in our works, as per the frequency of sampling & testing prescribed in the relevant I.S. Codes for different items of works. All mandatory tests of materials shall be conducted at site laboratory and the tests being got conducted outside shall be got done through reputed laboratories like Regional Engineering Colleges and I.I.T., M/s. Shriram Test Lab. (Private Engineering colleges & polytechnic not allowed).

If in test report particular material does not conform to provision of estimate/I.S. Code, Chief Engineer should be informed and whole lot should be rejected. ESIC will also make arrangement independently for test as per agreement clauses and non-conforming material/product will not only be rejected but punitive action will also be initiated against the construction agency.

The above orders be complied strictly and the compliance in this regard, alongwith details of tests conducted, be sent to us every month.
