- W.e.f.1st June, 2011 all the SBI branches located all over India shall accept contributions only through system generated challans. No conventional /hand written challans will be accepted by any of our branches thereafter.

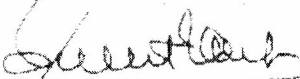

Power Jyoti Account-Collection of contribution

ESIC maintains their Power Jyoti accounts with our New Delhi Main Branch for collection contributions. The contributions are collected by various branches across the country through challans and remitted to NDMB for credit to ESIC accounts. In this connection we refer e-circular number NBG/SMEBU-POWERJYOTI/24/2010-11 DATED 09.08.2010 and e-circular number NBG/SMEBU-POWERJYOTI/83/2010-11 dated 17.01.2011 issued by Corporate Centre, Mumbai, regarding the captioned subject.

2. We understand that branches are facing difficulties in collection of ESIC contributions on account of information gaps and accordingly request you to please arrange for issuing e-circular incorporating the following points:

- ESIC challans will be accepted by all the branches.
- Clearing cheques cannot be posted directly into the Power Jyoti Accounts, as it does not have an additional data entry screen, hence branches will open a Intermediary account for collection of clearing cheques of other banks for ESIC collection and after realization the realized amount will be credited in any of the five pooling accounts.
- In case of Multicity Cheques in Non Home Centres, the amount credited in CBS is less than Rs.25/- per transaction due to Non Home transaction charges. However in such cases full amount is shown in MIS. Hence, Multicity Cheques should not be used /accepted by the branches in Non Home Centres.
- Branches should not post manual challans in these Power Jyoti Accounts under any circumstances.
- Branches should not use "Batch Posting Mode" in these Power Jyoti Accounts.
