Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to the above references, wherein instructions were issued regarding eligibility criteria for LDCE owing to IRT cases up to the cadre of HC/Assistant.

In this context, it is again reiterated with reference to the instructions cited above, laid down the policy for IRTs in Group 'C' & 'D' posts up to the cadre of Head Clerk/Assistant and inter alia provide that the transferee will be ranked junior most to all the officials in the respective base cadre of the opted region. Consequent upon Inter Regional Transfer of some LDCs and their appearing in the Limited Departmental Tests the regulation of eligibility criteria of three years of regular service in the feeder cadre for appearing in the LDCE has been examined and it is observed that these candidates have been allowed to appear in LDCE because they fulfilled the eligibility criteria of three years of qualifying service in the parent region and the vacancies against which they appeared in Departmental Examination also pertained to the said Region. Hence, the candidates who applied for the examination from their parent region and have appeared in the examination in their transferred region or the candidates who have been transferred on IRT to a new region after appearing in the examination from their parent region, shall be offered promotion in their **parent region only** subject to their finding place in the merit list of that region.

Further, the UDC/Assistant being a regional cadre, the candidates are to be considered for selection and promotion against the vacancies of the region where they have completed three years of regular service and fulfill the eligibility criteria. Accordingly, the employees who have undergone

Inter Regional Transfers, promotion in such cases shall also be considered only after their having completed the requisite qualifying service in the transferred region.
