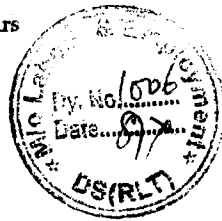
Dear Secretary,

The National Foundation for Communal Harmony (NFCH) was set up in 1992 as an autonomous organization under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, with the main objective of promoting communal harmony and strengthening national integration. Apart from other activities aimed at promoting communal harmony and national integration, the Foundation provides financial assistance for physical and psychological rehabilitation of children rendered orphan or destitute in communal, caste, ethnic or terrorist violence. Upto March 2009, the Foundation has rendered financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 30 crore to 9945 such children.

2. Every year, the Foundation organises communal harmony campaign to coincide with the *Quami Ekta Week* and observes the Flag Day. This year, the Communal Harmony Campaign Week will be observed from 19th to 25th November 2009 and the Flag Day on 25th November 2009. ~~It would be~~ appropriate if the Communal Harmony Campaign Week is observed befittingly in your Ministry/Department during the said period. A campaign comprising cultural programmes, seminars, debates, painting competitions, etc., would be timely and appropriate to effectively promote the values of communal harmony and national integration amongst the people. Efforts should also be made to organize a determined and sustained drive to bring about mass awakening against violence which impinges on social harmony, by making appropriate projection through the media. In this effort, sports, film and other prominent personalities could also be associated. The Foundation will soon be dispatching posters, sticker flags and other publicity material for the campaign. Annexed to this letter are guidelines on arrangements to be made for observing the Communal Harmony Campaign Week.

Annexure

**Steps to be taken for observing the Communal Harmony Campaign,
the Fund Raising Week and the Flag Day**

- (i) Organizing intensive campaign and wide publicity for sensitising students about the need for fostering communal harmony, national integration and fraternity through cultural programmes, debates, seminars, workshops, essay/painting competitions etc.;
- (ii) Making arrangements for circulation of fund collection boxes. Plastic, wooden or metallic boxes may be improvised with suitable openings. To avoid any complaints, the lid may be sealed;
- (iii) Additional wrappers for fund collection boxes may be duplicated in case of shortage;
- (iv) Selection of volunteers, both male and female, from amongst staff and students to station themselves at the entrance and other vantage points and go around the buildings on the **Flag Day** for distribution of flags etc. and collection of donation;
- (v) Making suitable arrangements for proper security of collection boxes, opening them and counting the amount collected; and
- (vi) Remittance of funds so collected to the **Secretary, National Foundation for Communal Harmony, 9th Floor, 'C' Wing, Lok Nayak Bhavan, Khan Market, New Delhi -110003**, through a demand draft. No bank charges are levied for making of such bank drafts by any of the branches of the following banks throughout the country:
(a) Union Bank of India, (b) United Bank of India & (c) Bank of Maharashtra.

The bank draft should be sent only through registered post and never by a private courier.

- (vii) Donation can also be made by direct Bank transfer from anywhere in India, utilizing the following information:
