C I R C U L A R

Sub: Provision of cancer treatment for the cases not manageable in E.S.I. Hospitals in respect of Insured Person, ESIC Employees/ Pensioners and their dependents covered under ESI Scheme, Delhi/New Delhi/Noida through tie-up arrangement with private Institutions.

In pursuance of Hqrs. letter number V.24/11/5/2007-Med.I (Policy Tie-up) dated 25th June, '09 and Hqrs. letters of the same number dated 20th May '09 and dated 1st June, '09, 25, March, 2010 and in continuation of this office earlier circular of even no. dated 17.6.09, 12.8.09 and 4.12.2009 tie-up arrangement has been made **with effect from up to 28.04.2010 upto 31.05.2010** on cashless basis with the following Hospital for treatment of cancer cases not manageable in E.S.I. Hospitals in r/o Insured Persons, ESIC employees/Pensioners and their dependents covered under ESI Scheme, Delhi/New Delhi/Noida :-

The salient terms and conditions of the tie-up arrangement are as under :-

- I. The Hospital will give 10% discount on their current schedule of rates. A copy of the current schedule of rates will be provided by the Hospital to the office of the Director (Medical) Delhi/Noida and also to the respective Medical Superintendents of E.S.I. Hospitals in Delhi/New Delhi.
- II. The discount will, however, not be applicable in case of medicines and consumables.
- III. During the validity of agreement, the rates will remain the same.
- IV.
 - a) The tie-up arrangement shall be for the general/economy ward only so far as Insured Persons & their dependants are concerned. In case, for some reason, the empanelled Centre provides higher accommodation to a patient (Insured Person or his/her dependant) referred by ESIC, ESIC will restrict the payment with reference to economy/general ward only.
 - b) However, serving or retired ESIC employees/pensioners will be entitled to the class of accommodation as per their entitlement under CGHS/CCS (MA) Rules and the empanelled Centre would allow 10% discount in the tariff where higher accommodation (than economy/general ward) is provided based on the entitlement. The entitlement status will be specified by the referring authority in the Reference letter/slip.
- V.
 - a) The empanelled centre will provide treatment only to referred beneficiaries, referred under the signature of Medical Superintendent, (A Unit of Crosslay Remedies Pvt. Ltd.) E.S.I. Hospital

b) In emergency, the patient referred from any of the above E.S.I. Hospital shall be provided the emergency treatment and approval from the competent authority as mentioned under clause (v) (a) above shall be obtained by next working day.

VI. The empanelled Hospital shall provide services only for the treatment facilities for which it has been empanelled by ESIC at rates as per SI. (I) above.

VII. **The procedure for submission / payment of bills will be as under:-**

The bill will be submitted for payment on monthly basis by 7th of the following month by the Empanelled Centre to the Medical Superintendent of the ESI Hospital concerned, from where the reference/permission to the empanelled Centre was issued **and it will be paid by ESIC within thirty days of the receipt of the bill.**


VII. The empanelled hospital will not refer the patient to other specialist/other hospital without prior permission of ESIC authorities.

VIII. The empanelled Centre shall not take any deposit of any kind or any amount of money in lieu of depositing at the time of admission from the referred E.S.I. beneficiaries.

IX. The empanelled Centre shall directly charge the individuals for a) Telephone charges (b) extra diet charges, so incurred by the patient or any of his family members during their stay in the empanelled Centre.

X. It may be noted that the reference is to be made to the above Institution for the cases not manageable in E.S.I. Hospitals.
