The Computer Based Exam. for the post of MTS for different Regions in ESIC was held between 19<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 to 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2016.

Vide Notice dated 29.4.2016, a link was also provided to all candidates for viewing the (1) Questions (2) Correct Answers and (3) Answers Marked by the Candidate in the Online Examination for the post of MTS and submitting Objections (if any) by 6.5.2016 was uploaded on ESIC Website. Thereafter, vide Notice Dated: 20.06.2016, the Question Paper along with Final Answer Keys were uploaded on ESIC website.

**The Region/Office wise Combined Merit List for the post of MTS is uploaded separately with this Notice.**

The Combined Merit List for the post of MTS for Gujarat and Himachal Pradesh Region is not uploaded due to enforcement of Model Code of Conduct in these States and the result for these regions will be declared in due course.

While utmost care has been taken in preparing and uploading the Result/Merit Lists, possibility of inadvertent / technical errors cannot be ruled out. The ESIC reserves the right to rectify the same later on.

The result for MTS shall be processed by the concerned ESIC Office/Region which has issued the Recruitment Notification/Advertisement. The concerned ESIC Office/Region are being advised separately by this Office for processing of results.
