### **CIRCULAR**

Implementation of 'Dhanwantri Module' (Health Information System application software) in ESIC/ ESIS Hospitals/Dispensaries has been regarded as one of the top priority activities.

Though the application was rolled out in June, 2011, only about 75% of the hospitals and 40% of the dispensaries in the states have implemented the module upto May, 2014. Some of the ESIC hospitals such as Bari Brahmna (Jammu) and Model Hospital, Indore, etc., are performing well and have adopted almost all sub-modules. Similarly, dispensaries in Delhi, Gujarat and Goa are performing much better than other states.

In this context, the competent authority has ordered that all the ESI hospitals and dispensaries ought to strive hard for implementation of the 'Dhanwantri Module' to provide advantage to the beneficiaries as envisaged under this prestigious project. It can be achieved by proactive approach & concerted efforts by the MS/ Dean /Directorate/IMO I/C, State Nodal Officers (SNO/OSD) / Nodal Officers and regular monitoring by the State/ Directorate /Hospital Level Coordination Committee. Challenges related to IT Infra may be addressed through IT Help Desk, while the office of the Regional Directors / SMC / Directorate should extend all possible assistance to SNO/MS/Dean/IMO I/C of Dispensaries/Hospitals.

**Locations where full implementation has not happened, OPD Registration, Capturing of Diagnosis / disease classifications (ICD), Admissions & Discharges by all hospitals and OPD Registration, Capturing of Diagnosis / disease classifications (ICD) & Certifications by all dispensaries, using this module are the minimum implementation status that needs to be achieved by August 2014.**

All location InCharge/ Head of Office of hospitals / dispensaries / Stores / Directorate are requested to review the progress at their level and bring about the impetus in implementation of 'Dhanwantri Module' of Project 'Panchdeep'.
