ADDENDUM / CORRIGENDUM

Subject: Award of work on nomination basis

Reference is invited to following circulars regarding execution of Capital and Special Repair Works issued by Hqrs. Office:-

- i) Circular No. W-17/11/CA/09-PMD dated 06.05.2013 – Special Repair Works of ESIC Buildings through State PSUs on Deposit Work Basis.
- ii) Circular No. W-17/11CA/09-PMD dated 16.05.2013 – Special Repairs of ESIC owned buildings and Capital Works within the delegated powers of RDs / JDs (I/c) / SSMCs / SMCs, / MSs of ESIC hospitals / Director Medical (Delhi & Noida) through the State PSUs on deposit work basis.
- iii) Circular No. W-17/11/CA/09-PMD dated 16.07.2013 – Special Repair Works beyond the delegated powers of RDs / SSMCs / JDs (I/c) / MSs / DMD i.e. between Rs. 15 Lakhs to Rs. 5 Crores.
- iv) Circular No. W-17/11/CA/09-PMD dated 16.07.2013 – Capital and Special Works within the delegated powers of RDs / SSMCs / SMCs / JDs (I) / MSs / DMD.

In the aforesaid circulars, it has been mentioned that State PSUs (approved by the State Finance Department by a general or a specific order for execution of projects funded out of state funds on 'Deposit Work Basis') and Construction Agencies empanelled with ESIC may be nominated to carry out the requisite works. In the light of the decision of ESI Corporation taken in 162nd Meeting held on 31.07.2014, the matter has been reviewed and the aforesaid circulars partially amended to exclude nomination of any Agency as a method to award work.

Instead, if necessary, the work may be assigned as per Rule 126 (2) of GFR, 2005, inter-alia ensuring compliance of all related GFR provisions and CVC Guidelines. Excerpts of Rule 126(2) of GFR, 2005 are given below for ready reference:-

“Rule 126(2)- A Ministry or Department may, at its discretion, assign repair works estimated to cost above Rupees Thirty Lakhs and original works of any value to any Public Works Organization, such as CPWD, State Public Works Division, other Central Government organizations authorized to carry out civil or electrical works such as Military Engineering service (MES), Border Roads Organization (BRO), etc., Public Sector Undertakings set up by the Central or State Government Organization to carry out civil or electrical works or any other Central/State Govt. organization/PSU which may be notified by the Ministry of Urban Development after evaluating their financial strength and technical competence.”

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Further, with the constitution of State Executive Committee (approved by ESI Corporation in its 162nd Meeting held on 31.07.2014). State Executive Committee is to monitor infrastructural issues and execution of repair works of all the ESIS Buildings, for which financial powers have been delegated to Committee for getting the work executed by CPWD or an agency of the State government, duly approved by the State Finance Department by a general or specific order. Details of financial powers delegated to State Executive Committee is enclosed as **Annexure 'I'**.

All other contents of the aforesaid four circulars remain unchanged.

ANNEXURE 'I'

Item.	Description of Powers	Extent of Powers
1.	To sanction Special Repair Works of ESI buildings being used by the State Governments. To have the Special Repair Works executed by CPWD or an agency of the State Government, duly approved by the State Finance Department by a general or specific order.	Dispensaries# Upto a ceiling of Rs. 50,00,000/-* (Fifty Lakh) in 5 years period** per dispensary. Hospitals# (i) Upto 200 beds - up to a ceiling of Rs. 3,00,00,000/-* (Three Crore) in 5 years period**. (ii) More than 200 beds - Up to a ceiling of Rs. 5,00,00,000/-* (Five Crore) in 5 years period**.
2.	To sanction Annual Repair & Maintenance, including operation and maintenance of essential services.	As per CPWD Plinth Area Rates, within the overall budgetary allocation given by ESIC under the ARM head for that State.

** Estimated amount for Special Repairs, in one or more phases, shall not exceed the total prescribed ceiling amount during the entire 5 year period. 5 years period is to be counted from the financial year succeeding the date of sanction in a particular financial year.

* Proposals of Special Repairs beyond the prescribed financial limit may be sent to ESIC Hqrs.

Proposals of Special Repairs of Staff Quarters attached to Dispensaries / Hospitals shall be dealt by RD/SSMC within their delegated powers and those requiring expenditures above the delegated powers need to be sent to ESIC Hqrs as per extant instructions.
