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2. Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC)

Shri B.N. Tripathy, CVO, ESIC informed that the main activity of the Corporation is to provide medical care and cash benefits to insured persons in the organized sectors in the contingencies of sickness, maternity, disablement and death and due to employment injury. In order to upgrade the quality of service to the beneficiaries of ESI Scheme, a comprehensive IT enabled project is in place. This IT rollout has enabled the employers and insured persons to register online payment of contributions, etc. IT usage and e-governance has resulted in curbing delayed payments to the insured persons. Registration can be done online and payment of contribution can also be made online. The employee will know how much the employer is deducting towards his contribution and the system is very transparent. CVO, ESIC intimated that the vigilance cases have come down considerably due to various measures taken by the Corporation. He informed that most of the vigilance cases involve private practice of doctors of ESIC.

VC(S) referring to ESIC motto that the insured persons (IPs) are most important person, commended their computerization efforts and said it has started changing the lives of six crores of IPs. He desired that all organizations should take inspiration from ESIC, study it and implement similar computerization in their organization.

VC(G) informed that procedure for treatment of patients with terminal illness need more attention especially when the treatment is outsourced and the terminal patient is asked to come every 15 days for renewal of permission. He desired that a complaint mechanism be put in place for this and all officials involved in the field have to be sensitized on this aspect.

Action Points - ESIC

1. Expedite pending reports on complaints and action on first stage advice.
2. Mechanism to be put in place and sensitization of field staff for preventing ill-treatment of terminal patients.

3. Ministry of Labour & Employment

Sh. A.C. Pandey, Jt. Secretary & CVO informed that vigilance cases pertaining to the Ministry are very few as compared to its attached offices and subordinate formations. There is only one case in the Ministry pending for implementation of Commission's first stage advice. Computerized file tracking system was introduced and tenders are put on the website. He assured that the EPFO will have centralized online service very soon.

On query by VC(S), whether e-tendering is being followed, the CVO informed that it would be done by next quarter. VC(S) further added that mere publishing of tender online is not enough, processing, monitoring and payments also should be online. VC(S) also enquired whether the labour cess collected by the States (1% of every project) is being spent for labour welfare. VC(S) cited example of CWG where labour cess was not collected and hence the Ministry should look into this aspect for improving collection of labour cess and some parameters to be set to spend this amount on the welfare of labourers. CVO informed that DG (Labour Welfare) is holding meeting with the concerned States and the progress will be intimated after consulting DG (Labour Welfare). VC(G) asked the CVO to examine the aspect of fixing liability of persons responsible for deduction of 1% labour cess from the vendors/contractors bills. CVO assured the Commission to revert on the matter soon.
