Sub: Prevention of Vector Borne diseases like Malaria, Dengue and Chickengunia in Government Offices.

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware that Vector Borne diseases like Malaria, Dengue, chickengunia etc. rise during and after the monsoon. Effective preventive and control measures are required to keep in check these vector borne diseases. The hospital / dispensary/offices are using air-coolers etc. extensively and mosquitoes thrive and breed in stored / stagnant water in domestic and peri-domestic areas and office complexes. Water remaining unattended in desert coolers serve as an ideal breeding ground for mosquitoes.

For carrying the anti-vector campaign in the hospitals, dispensaries and offices under ESIC, Director General has appointed the following officers as Nodal officer :-

1. Director (Med.) Delhi for all dispensaries in Delhi.
2. Medical Superintendents of all ESIC hospitals in Delhi / Noida for their respective hospitals.
3. Regional Director / Jt. Director (Incharge) for the Regional Office, Division Offices / SROs, Branch Offices under their jurisdiction.
4. A.C. (P&A) for Hqrs. Office.

Nodal Officer may also organize awareness campaign within their unit in consultation with the respective municipal health and other local agencies.
