Sub: Involvement of Local Committee Members in IT Roll Out
"Project Panchdeep" – reg.

Sir,

I am directed to inform you that during the last Corporation meeting, it was brought out by few members that Local Committee Meetings are not being held regularly with the result that several local issues remain unresolved and members of the Committee unaware of various initiatives taken by the Corporation. Hqrs. Office, time and again, has stressed on holding of local committee meetings regularly and also to keep an agenda item on "local committees and important decisions thereof" for discussion in the Regional Board Meetings. You are, therefore, requested to monitor holding of Local Committee Meetings in your Region including re-constitution of such Committees which have outlived their tenure. It is desired by the Insurance Commissioner that a para on "Regional Board and Local Committees" may be included in your monthly DO letter from January, 2010.

2. You are aware that issue of Smart Cards to Insured Persons and their families is an important ongoing project and active involvement of Local Employers' Associations and Trade Unions is necessary for its success. Branch Managers and Officers of Regional Office may, therefore, be advised to keep Employers' Associations, Trade Unions and Members of Regional Board and Local Committees informed of the progress of the project and take their assistance for successful completion of the project as per time schedule issued by the Systems Division, Hqrs. Office.

3. The Insurance Commissioner has expressed concern on non utilization of power for advance payment of PDB after termination of TDB in cases of scheduled injuries in which the loss of earning capacity is not likely to be assessed less than 25% as indicated in the Branch Office Manual. The advance payment is to be in consultation with Medical Referee and in cases in which a reference to medical board for assessment of loss of earning capacity is likely to be delayed.

4. The contents of this communication may be brought to the notice of all Branch Officers, Branch Managers and Insurance Inspectors in all the Regions.
