Sub: Provision of secondary medical care services in areas / districts where the existing ESI Hospitals are more than 25 Kms from the concentration of Insured Persons – revision of criteria.

Sir/Madam,

Kindly refer to this Office letter of even nos. dt. 03.03.10 & 25 .03.10 on the subject noted above. In this regard, it is informed that while doing mapping it was observed that many areas could not be covered as the IP concentration in these areas were less than 25000 ~~IPs~~. Therefore, to further facilitate provision of secondary medical care services to the Insured Persons and their families at a reasonable distance and cover more areas, the Chairman, ESI Corporation has approved the revision of criterias for making secondary care arrangement as under:

Sl. No.	Distance from existing ESI / ESIC Hospital	No. of IPs
1.	More than 125 kms.	10000 or more
2.	75 to 125 kms.	15000 or more
3.	25 to 75 kms.	25000 or more

Rest of the terms and conditions will remain same.

It is requested that necessary action in this regard may be taken by all concerned.

These instructions will come into force with immediate effect.
