**NOTIFICATION**

S.O. : Whereas, by a notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Labour & Employment number S.O. 47 dated the 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2008, the Central Government, in consultation with the Employees' State Insurance Corporation, gave notice of its intention to extend the provisions of the Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948 (34 of 1948) to certain classes of establishments specified in the Schedule to the said notification after six months from the date of that notification.

And whereas, the copies of the said notification were made available to the public on 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2009.

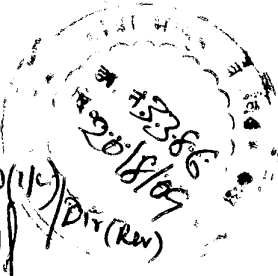
And whereas, no objections and suggestions have been received within the said period of six months in respect of the said notification.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5) of section of the Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948 (34 of 1948), the Central Government, in consultation with the Employees' State Insurance Corporation, hereby extends the provisions of the said Act to the classes of establishments specified in column (1) and situated within the area, specified in column (2) of the Schedule to the category of employees specified in column (3) of the said Schedule, namely:-
