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**Sub : Regarding Issue of C-19 after giving 60 days time**

Sir,

As you are aware that Appellate Authority has been created by recent amendment to the ESI Act, 1948 for matters related to 45-A Order. As per existing practice, 30 days time is given to the employer to comply with orders with stipulation that no appeal lies against the order passed under section 45-A. However, in view of creation of Appellate Authority, where 60 days time is given to the employer to file an appeal against the order, it is essential that Authorized Officer should give 60 days time before issuing C-19 and make mention of Appellate provision in the Speaking Order.

It is therefore advised that all 45-A orders must be issued incorporating above points in the order.
