PART II OF COMPUTER SKILL TEST FOR UDC ONLY

Part A - Preparation of two Power Points Presentations/Slides on MS-Power Points – 10 marks.

Part – B - Typing a letter/passage/paragraph of about 150-200 words in MS-Word. – 20 marks.

Part C - Preparation of Table/Database in MS-Excel – 20 Marks.

The total marks of the Computer Skill Test shall be 50 (Fifty) with duration of 30 minutes for completing all the three parts. The candidates will be given the textmatter in the Question paper which they have to type/reproduce in the Answer Sheet including formatting of text and use of formulas etc. as per instruction given in the Question Paper.

- a. The selection for the post of UDC will be made on the basis of written test (Part-I) objective typed followed by computer Skill Test (Part-II) of the candidates shortlisted on the basis of their performance in the written test (Part-I)
- b. The selection for the post of MTS will be made on the basis of written test of objective type only.
- c. Negative marking i.e. 0.25 marks will be deducted for every wrong answer to eliminate the element of chance.
