2. Learned Counsel for respondent nos. 2 to 4  
submits that she is not in a position to assist the Court  
and argue the matter today as instructed by  
respondents. According to respondents, the judgment  
delivered by the Madras High Court is questioned by  
C.B.S.C. before the Hon'ble Supreme Court, and till the  
controversy is decided by the Hon'ble Supreme Court,

the matter could not be looked into.

3. Learned Counsel for petitioners submits that the Hon'ble Supreme Court is not considering the controversy revolving around ESIC quota.

4. Learned Counsel for petitioners has also invited our attention to the fact that on last date of hearing a categorical statement was made by respondent nos. 2 to 4 that merit list in ESIC quota is already displayed on Website. According to him, no such list is uploaded till date.

5. He has produced before us printouts taken on 18.07.2018 in the evening to substantiate this. The said printouts are taken on record and marked as "Exh.A" for the purpose of identification.

6. Mrs. Maldhure, learned counsel submits that hard copy of list which was displayed on the Website, was shown by her to the Court.

7. However, as learned counsel for respondent nos. 2 to 4 has instructions not to argue the matter further, we adjourn the same for further consideration on 26.07.2018, as requested by learned counsel for respondents. However, till then admission in ESIC quota shall not be finalized.
