## **Important Instructions for Bidders**

All bidders/contractors are required to procure Class-III B Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) with Both DSC Components i.e. Signing & Encryption to participate in the E- Tenders.

Bidder needs to submit Bid Processing Fee charges of Rs. 2495/- (non-refundable) in the form of Demand Draft from any scheduled bank in favour of M/s. C1 India Pvt. Ltd., payable at New Delhi (or in any other form as acceptable by C1 India Pvt. Ltd.) for participating in the Tender.

Along with the Demand Draft, Bidder needs to send a covering Letter mentioning about the Payment Details, Company Name, Address, User ID and Payment towards ESIC Bid Processing Fees (Mention the Tender ID and Tender Title).

## Part -I Scope of Work

1. The Tenderer shall provide One Ambulance of make not prior to 2016, round the clock without any disruption. The vehicle should run on either Petrol or diesel only.
2. The Ambulances should be in excellent condition equipped with collapsible stretcher, oxygen cylinder with mask, IV bottle holding hook, First aid box and overhead beacon (siren).
3. The Ambulance is required for transportation of patients along with attendants from ESIC Hospital, Varanasi to tie up Hospitals/ Govt. Hospitals in Varanasi. The Ambulances may also be used for purpose not expressly specified in the Tender document and may have to go outside in addition to the areas mentioned above.
4. In case the Ambulance breaks down en-route, the contractor shall immediately arrange alternate Ambulance for transportation of patients. Any failure to provide alternate Ambulance within a reasonable time shall be considered as failure to provide the services and or breach of contract.
5. In case of non- availability of Ambulance for whatever reason, the ESIC Hospital would arrange on its own for shifting of patients and expenditure so incurred shall be recovered from the monthly bill of the Tenderer besides deduction of Rs 500/- (rupees five hundred only) as penalty for each default.
6. The Tenderer shall provide a mobile phone to the drivers at the cost of tenderer. Further the mobile numbers would be intimated to the Casualty Medical Officer/Security/Administration department on duty in writing compulsorily.
7. The Tenderer/ bidder would manage shifting of Drivers in such a manner that the 24 hours service should not be interrupted. Tendered should provide 3 drivers normally except in case of emergent situation. In any case driver will not be permitted to work continuously for more than 12 hours.
8. The contractor/successful bidder shall submit a copy of RC Book of the vehicle, Insurance papers, Driver's license and their mobile no. to the Administration department of the Hospital within 15 days of award of contract (Letter of Award).

9. The bidder shall maintain a logbook keeping records of the movement of vehicles. Such records will be certified by the Emergency Medical Officer on duty or any other person Authorized by the ESIC Hospital Varanasi.

10. The contractor should have an office in the Varanasi or within a radius of 100 KM from the City.

## **Part- II. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS**

1. Sealed Tender are invited from the registered agencies for providing ambulance service for ESIC Model Hospital, Varanasi on contract basis for a period of one year. The contract is renewable for a further period of one year on mutual consent at the same rate, terms and conditions and subject to satisfactory performance of the contractor.

2. The tender document may be downloaded from the [www.esic.nic.in/tenders.php](http://www.esic.nic.in/tenders.php). The downloaded tender document should be submitted along with tender fee by way of a demand draft of Rs 500/- (Five Hundred only) of any Nationalized bank drawn in favour of "ESI Fund Account No. 1" payable at Varanasi. The tender form can also be purchased from the Administration Branch of the Hospital by making a payment of prescribed fee through demand draft payable in favor of "ESI Fund Account No. 1" payable at Varanasi.

3. Eligibility Criteria:

- The Tenderer should have the Registered / Branch Office in Varanasi.
- Shop and Estt. registration certificate or any other registration which is mandatory for running such Agency prescribed by the concerned authority from time to time.
- Copy of PAN Number.
- M.S. reserves the right to modify or relax the eligibility criteria in case none of the tenderer is able to fulfill the required criteria. No relaxation will be given as far as statutory requirements are concerned.

4. Bid Security/ Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

- EMD for Rs. 18,000/- (Rupees Eighteen Thousand only) in the form of Demand Draft from any nationalised bank drawn in favour of "ESI Fund A/c No 1" payable at Varanasi, shall accompany the bid.
- EMD shall remain valid for a period of 90 days.
- A bid received without Bid security (EMD) shall be rejected at the bid opening stage.
- The earnest money deposit (EMD) shall be refunded to the unsuccessful Tenderers after finalization of the contract. No interest is payable on the EMD.

- EMD shall be refunded to the successful Tenderer on receipt of Security Deposit. EMD shall not be adjusted towards Security Deposit.
- The bid security/EMD may be forfeited, if a Bidder withdraws his bid during the specified period of bid validity specified in the bid document.
- In case of successful bidder, the EMD shall be forfeited, if the bidder fails to accept the offer of contract or Furnish the Performance security within the time specified in the document.

5. Submission of Bid:

- The Tenderers are required to submit Bid to the Administration branch in a sealed envelope and it should be super scribed as “Tender for Ambulance Service in ESIC Hospital Varanasi. The tender must reach on or before the last date of submission/time.
- No bids will be accepted after the expiry of the prescribed date and time for submission of the bids, for whatsoever reasons.
- M.S. ESIC Hospital, Varanasi, may, at his discretion, extend the deadline for submission of bids.

6. The sealed envelope should contain the following:

- Tender form alongwith all its annexures duly signed on each and every page by the tenderer.
- In case the Tender form has been downloaded from the website, it should be accompanied with Tender form fee of Rs.500/- (Non refundable) in the form of Demand Draft from a nationalized bank drawn in favour of “ESI Fund A/c No -1” payable at Varanasi.
- Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 18,000/- in the form of Demand Draft from a nationalized bank drawn in favour of “ESI Fund A/c No -1”, payable at Varanasi.
- The declaration in the prescribed proforma (Annexure -I) enclosed should be submitted along with the Bid.
- Bid in proforma Annexure-II.
- Shop and Estt registration certificate or any other registration which is mandatory for running such Agency prescribed by the concerned authority from time to time.
- Copy of PAN Number.
- Checklist in proforma Annexure III
- Cancelled cheque of the Tenderer.

7. All the entries/documents submitted in the bid must be legible and self-attested along with the seal of the firm. Any overwriting which is unavoidable shall be signed by the authorized signatory. Otherwise the bid will be rejected.

8. Bid Opening and Evaluation.
  - The bid shall be opened in the chamber of Assistant Director (Administration) by the Officers authorized by the Medical Superintendent on the due date and time in the presence of the bidders or their representatives duly authorized by the bidder who wish to remain present.
  - All the bids will be scrutinized and relevant documents will be checked for their eligibility.
9. Contacting the officials
  - No bidder shall try to influence the Hospital administration on any matter relating to its bid, from the time of the bid opening till the time contract is awarded.
  - Any effort by the bidder to influence the Hospital administration in the bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract award decision shall result in the rejection of the bid.
11. Validity of the bid: The tenders shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of tender.
12. No Tenderer will be allowed to withdraw after submission of the tenders within the bid validity period otherwise the EMD submitted by the tendering firm would stand forfeited.
13. Tenders received and found deficient on account of registrations documents or any required information are liable to be rejected summarily. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
14. The Tenders from Individual/Firm/Organization including its Partners/ Shareholders/ Directors who have been blacklisted/prosecuted by any departments/statutory bodies in any State or by any Court of Law, shall not be entertained. Each bidder shall submit only one tender either by himself or as a partner in joint venture or as a member of consortium. If a bidder or if any of the partners in a joint venture or any one of the members of the consortium participate in more than one bid, their bids are liable to be rejected.
15. The bidder shall submit full details of his Agency / firm or, if the bidder is proprietor /partnership or a Private Limited Company, full details of ownership and name of the Directors. If the bidder is a Registered Company / partnership of two or more persons,

all such persons shall be jointly and severally liable to the Hospital for the fulfillment of the terms of the contract. Such persons shall designate one of them to act as authorized signatory with authority to sign. The Company / partnership shall not be altered without the approval of the Hospital authority.

16. The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, Forms, Terms and conditions in the tender document. Failure to furnish all information required in the tender document or submission of a tender not substantially responsive to the tender document in every respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in rejection of his bid.

17. All the information as required in the tender document should be filled up in the relevant part and no column should be left unfilled. An incomplete tender document or tender document submitted without tender fee and Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) will be summarily rejected.

18. Tenderer signing the tender must clearly specify whether he is signing as sole proprietor, partner, under power of attorney or as Director/Manager/Secretary etc., as the case may be.

19. Non transferability: This tender is non transferable and can't be sublet or subcontracted.

20. Any conditional acceptance is liable for rejection of tender.

20. The Medical Superintendent ESIC Hospital, Varanasi, reserves the right to accept or reject any bid including the lowest and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders of the grounds for the said action.

21. Medical Superintendent ESIC Hospital, Varanasi will award the contract to the successfully evaluated bidder whose bid is found to be responsive and who is eligible and qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily as per the terms and conditions incorporated in the bidding document.

22. The Contractor who has quoted the least rate against "monthly charges" shall be considered as the lowest Tenderer.

23. In case more than one bid quoting the same rates are received, the award of the contract will be decided on the basis of following

- A. First Priority will be given to new vehicle as per the year of purchase. If the vehicle is yet to be purchased then the year will be considered as "2017".
- B. Second priority will be given to tenderer quoting lower rate in "Beyond 1500 km".
- C. Third priority will be given to tenderer having more experience.

24. The successful bidder will be informed by Registered post/e-mail that his bid has been accepted (hereinafter and in the condition of contract called the "Letter of Award")

25. The successful bidder will be required to execute an agreement in proforma **Annexure IV** within a period of 15 days from the date of issue of Letter of Award until extended by the M.S. ESIC Hospital, Varanasi on a non judicial stamp paper of Rs 100/- and all the expenditure in this regard should be borne by the bidder.

26. The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance Security within 15 days of receipt of "Letter of Award" for an amount of Rs. 60,000.00 or 10 % of final contract value whichever is higher through a Demand Draft from a nationalized bank drawn in favour of "ESI Fund A/c No 1", payable at Varanasi. The Performance Security / Security Deposit shall be returned after two months after the expiry of contract and completion of all contractual obligations. In case the contract period is extended further, the validity of Performance Security shall stand automatically extended.

27. This Security deposit will not bear any interest of whatsoever kind.

28. Each page of the Tender document should be signed and stamped by authorized representative of Tenderer in acceptance of the terms and conditions laid down by ESIC.

29. Tender containing false, misleading information will be rejected and will also be liable for consequences for submitting false information.

30. The Medical Superintendent ESIC Hospital, Varanasi does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders, either in whole or in part, without assigning any reasons for doing so.

31. Medical Superintendent may at his discretion, amend/modify the tender and/or extend the deadline for submission of tenders at any time prior to the last date for submission of Tenders. Medical Superintendent may for any reason at his own initiative may modify the Tender documents by amendment and information thereof will be uploaded on Corporation's website and shall be binding on all concerned



32. In case the tenderer wishes to provide a new vehicle the same should be mentioned clearly in the space marked for “year of manufacture of ambulance” in the bid.
33. The competent authority reserves the right to withdraw/relax any of the terms and conditions mentioned above.
34. Medical Superintendent ESIC Hospital, Varanasi is the Competent Authority to renew Contract or to terminate contract.
35. All disputes relating to this tender can be legally resolved through court in Varanasi only

### **Part- III. TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. The vehicle offered should have all the facilities/potentialities supposed to be available in a standard Ambulance. The Ambulances should be in excellent condition equipped with collapsible stretcher, oxygen cylinder with mask, IV bottle holding hook, First aid box and overhead beacon (siren).
2. The Vehicle should be of a make not prior to 2016. The vehicle should run on either Petrol or diesel only.
3. The driver engaged should have valid driving license and should be co-operative and amiable in nature.
4. The driver provided should not have any past history of criminal records or Alcoholism or Drug Addiction.
5. The Tenderer/ bidder would manage shifting of Drivers in such a manner that the 24 hours service should not be interrupted. Tendered should provide 3 drivers normally except in case of emergent situation. In any case driver will not be permitted to work continuously for more than 12 hours.
6. The driver(s) employed by the tenderer/bidder shall have proper and valid driving licenses and physical fitness certificate for driving as required by law and shall have mental fitness and satisfy all conditions as required by Transport Authority and should also have experience of driving four wheelers.
7. The drivers supplied should not be above 55 years of age. They should be supplied with an uniform in white color by the bidder/contractor.
8. The persons provided by the contractor shall be the employee of the contractor only and there is no Master and Servant or Employer and Employee relationship between the persons provided by the contractor and this Hospital. Further the said persons of the contractor shall not claim any employment, engagement or absorption in this Hospital, in future.
9. The Hospital shall not be under any obligation for providing employment to any of the driver of the contractor after the expiry of the contract. The Hospital does not recognize any employee-employer relationship with any of the workers of then contractor.
10. The contractor has to indemnify the ESIC against all claims, damages or compensation under the provisions of Central Minimum wages Act, 1948 and other Labour laws in force from time to time including Payment of Wages Act, 1936; Employer's Liability Act, 1938; the Workman Compensation Act, 1923; Industrial Disputes Act, ; Maternity Benefit Act, 1961; Bonus Act; Contract Labour (R & A) Act 1970, or any modification thereof, Child Labour (Prohibition & Regulation) Act, 1986 Or any reenactment or modification of the same and any other Social Security benefits including prescribed number of leave / holidays and prescribed hours of work Schedule to the personnel deployed and all Acts related to Social Security (ESI & EPF etc), Service Tax wherever applicable & other Labour legislations, and such statutory

orders from time to time. ESIC will not own any responsibility in this regard and the Contractor will be liable for any consequences resulting from violation of any such rule / provision.

11. The Tenderer should have the vehicle registered as an Ambulance with appropriate authority. The vehicle should have proper valid Registration Certificate, Road tax payment Certificate, Fitness, Insurance and shall be in running condition, without any trouble at all.

12. The vehicle offered should confirm to the Emission norms laid down by Pollution Control Board and should possess a valid "Pollution under Control" certificate issued from the authorities concerned.

13. The vehicle offered for hire should be free from litigation as regards ownership is concerned and should possess no tainted history as rash driving, negligence or violation of traffic rule etc.

14. The vehicle should be kept ready for 24 hours a day, seven days a week without any kind of break. The Tenderer should arrange for replacement of vehicle in case of normal wear and tear/temporary out of service. Any expenditure towards wear and tear, repairing would be borne by the Tenderer/bidder.

15. The vehicle offered should only run on fuel registered in the R/C during the currency of agreement, if it is found that the vehicle is run on any other fuel, the agreement will be terminated & Security Deposit will be forfeited.

16. No increase in rate shall be permitted during the period of contract on any account whatsoever. The tenderer should keep this in consideration while quoting the rate. The tenderer will be however paid toll tax, parking etc on actual basis.

17. The condition of engine of vehicle should be good and adequate quantity of fuel should be provided by the Tenderer himself at his own cost.

18. The Vehicle offered should have seats in the patient's cabin for transporting more than one patient.

19. The legal liability arising out of Accident, if any, during the period of engagement would be borne by the Tenderer.

20. Any loss of property caused by the driver/vehicle would be recovered from the monthly bill of the Tenderer.

21. The Tenderer may note that in case of any failure or breach of the terms and conditions of contract which results in deficiency in delivery of medical care to patients in the ambulance van, including emergencies which has resulted due to deficiencies in services provided by the Tenderer thus leading to failure of providing services, the cost will be recoverable from the Tenderer in addition to attracting penalty.

22. Payment of wages and statutory obligations such as minimum wages etc., are to be mandatorily confirmed by the Tenderer. Statutory liability viz. ESI/EPF etc, would be solely borne by the Tenderer and no extra payment would be made on these accounts.

23. The Tenderer should quote the vehicle details that they are going to provide in the tender document itself. Bidders who are willing to offer new vehicle may also bid. In case such a bidder

is successful, he shall provide the vehicle within 21 days from the date of award, failing which his EMD shall be forfeited. Such bidder should mention the same fact clearly wherever required.

24. The Tenderer should keep the ambulance ready for inspection whenever called for. The Contractor should ensure the availability of ambulance with drivers to maintain adequate service and in case of any breach of terms and conditions a penalty of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five hundred Only) per incident shall be levied and deducted from the bill.

25. Whenever any claim for the payment of a sum of money arises out of or under this contract against the contractor the ESIC shall be entitled to recover of such sum by appropriating, in part or whole the security/earnest money deposited by the contractor, when the balance or the total sum to be recoverable, as the case may be shall be deducted from any sum then due or which at any time thereafter may become due to recoverable under this or any other agreement with the contractor, should this sum not be sufficient to cover the full amount recoverable, the contractor shall pay to the Hospital on demand the remaining balance due.

26. For any dispute regarding quality / service and rates the decision of the Medical Superintendent shall be final and binding on the Contractor.

27. Failure of the successful bidder to comply with the requirements of above clauses shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of Bid Security/ Security Deposit.

28. The security deposit amount will be refunded to the contractor without any interest, after 60 days of completion of the contract subject to Satisfactory Performance of the Contract.

29. The Security Deposit will be forfeited if the bidder violates any of the conditions of this contract.

30. The selected Service Provider shall be required to start the services in accordance with the time schedule specified in the work order issued by Medical Superintendent after acceptance of Tender. Extension will not be given except in exceptional circumstances. In case the services are not started on the stipulated date as indicated in the work order, Medical Superintendent reserves the right to cancel the work order and forfeit EMD and/or Security Deposit.

31. In case the Service Provider/contractor discontinues the contract before the expiry of the period of contract, his Security Deposit shall be forfeited.

32. The Medical Superintendent also reserves the right to terminate the contract in whole or in part by giving one month written notice, in advance, if the bidder fails to satisfy the conditions of this contract.

AND WHEREAS, , has participated in the above referred tender vide their quotation dated and the hospital has accepted their aforesaid tender and awarded the contract for Ambulance Services for Hospital on the terms & conditions contained in the tender document which has been unequivocally accepted by the Contractor vide their declaration given as per **Annexure- I** of Tender document along with their bid.

### **NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT/DEED WITNESSETH AS UNDER: ARTICLE 1.0 AWARD OF CONTRACTOR**

1.1 The Hospital has awarded the contract to the contractor for Ambulance Service for ESIC Hospital Varanasi on the terms & conditions contained in the tender document. The contract will take effect from , 2017 and will be valid for a period of two years which may be extended for a further period of one year based on satisfactory performance and with mutual consent.

### **ARTICLE 2.0 – CONTRACT DOCUMENTS**

5. Following documents shall form an integral part of this Agreement, in so far as the same or any part thereof, to the tender documents. For the sake of brevity, this agreement along with following contract documents shall be referred to as the "Contract":

### **ARTICLE 3.0- CONDITIONS & COVENANTS**

8. The scope of work shall also include all such items which are not specifically mentioned in the contract but reasonably implied for the satisfactory completion of the entire scope of work envisaged under this contract.
9. The Contractor shall adhere to all requirements stipulated in the contract documents.
10. Time is essence of the Contract and it shall be strictly adhered to.
11. This agreement constitutes full and complete understanding between the parties and terms of the presents. It shall supersede all prior correspondence to the extent of inconsistency or repugnancy to the terms & conditions contained in this Agreement. Any modification of the Agreement shall be effected only by a written instrument signed by the authorized representative of both the parties.
12. The total contract price for the entire scope of this contract is Rs. ( Rupees only) excluding the Service tax as applicable, upto 1500 km per Ambulance and afterwards @ Rs. (Rupees only) per km.

**ARTICLE 4.0 – NO WAIVER OF RIGHTS**

10. Hospital's failure to exercise or delay in exercising any right, power or privilege under this Agreement shall not operate as a waiver thereof; nor shall any single or partial exercise of any right, power or privilege preclude any other or further exercise thereof.

**ARTICLE 5.0 – GOVERNING LAWS AND JURISDICTION**

18. The Laws applicable to this contract shall be in the laws in force in India and courts in Varanasi alone will have jurisdiction to deal with matters arising there from, to the exclusion of all courts.

19. Notice of Default:

Notice of default given by either party to the other party under the Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly and properly served upon the parties here to, if delivered against acknowledgment due or by registered mail duly addressed to the signatories at the address mentioned herein above.
